FLAMINGO BAY WATER LODGE – MOZAMBIQUE

Situated in the pristine tidal bay of Inhambane, home to flocks of flamingo's, tropical fish and the very rare dugong. The cathedrals, old colonial Portuguese architecture, African culture and local markets make this a fascinating town to browse around. Quad Bikes

Quad biking through the coconut plantations opens new vistas and following the tracks and paths through these areas allows one to experience the real
