The public areas include restaurants, bars, and reading room or lecture hall. The ship's comfort and friendliness is enhanced by its intimate size without sacrificing service and convenience. This vessel features tourist class outside air-conditioned cabins with private bathroom facilities and a large picture window, affording majestic views of the passing countryside. ST. PETERSBURG Created by Peter the Great to rival Venice, its 101 islands, 66 canals, and hundreds of bridges have secured its reputation as the most beautiful city in the country. While your ship is docked in port you'll enjoy daily sightseeing tours. Time will be spent in the world-famous Hermitage Museum, formerly the Winter Palace, home of the last six Czars. This is a treasure trove of three million exhibits; its 320 halls display Da Vinci's, Rembrandts, Titians, Michelangelo's and French Impressionists.

MANDROGI Green Stop. In the village there are some structures built according to the Russian fine traditions of wooden architecture. Village dwellers meet the guests and organize something special for them. There is a museum of Russian Vodka where tourists can get acquainted with the history of the Russian vodka industry. Take a walk in the picturesque woods.

KIZHI ISLAND Via the Volga/Baltic Canal our cruise takes us to the tiny island of Kizhi located at the northern end of Lake Onega. Renowned for its open-air Museum of Architecture assembled from various areas of the country and restored to form a glimpse of the past, Kizhi is a feast for the eyes. The Transfiguration Church, with 22 domes, is the ultimate in Russian fairy-tale church architecture.



GORITZY A tiny settlement seven kilometres from the Kiritlo-Belozersky Monastery. Kirilo-Belorevsky men's monastery was founded in 1397; the monastery had traded widely in 15-17th centuries. At the end of 15-16th centuries the Monastery survived the siege of the Polish and Lithuanian invaders. The set of Kirilo-Belozersky monasteries includes the Uspensky and Ivanovsky monasteries Fortress walls, built in 1653-82 decorated with brick patterns surround the monastery.



YAROSLAVL Stretching for 18 miles on both banks of the Volga, Yaroslavl was founded in the 11th century by Prince Yaroslav the Wise. Of special interest is the magnificent 13th-century Spassky Monastery ensemble, a group of majestic 17th century cathedrals, a loveliest of all is the Church of Elijah the Prophet, situated in the town's central square. The frescoes on the walls and vaulting inside the church constitute a veritable museum of old Russian paintings.

UGLICH Founded in 1148, Uglich is one of the most beloved towns in old Russia. The view of the town as it is approached from the Volga River is especially lovely with the Cathedral of the Resurrection and St John's Church looming on the horizon. At the end of the 16th century, Maria Nagaya, seventh wife of Ivan the Terrible lived in honorary exile in the Kremlin in Uglich. It was here in her garden that the Tsarevich Dmitry met his death and where the Church of St. Demetrius of the Blood was built and still stands today.

MOSCOW You view the Kremlin, Visit Red Square and marvel at the Byzantine splendour of St. Basil's multi-coloured onion-domed cathedral.

EXTENSION TO TOUR: – Should you wish to extend in Paris after the cruise please note that confirmation of seats is subject to G class availability and must be requested at least 10 weeks prior to departure. The airline extension cost is **R 750 per person**, plus any additional airfare and airport tax. After full payment has been received no extensions or amendments will be possible. Should you extend in Europe, RSA passport holders require a Schengen visa.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: – Details on benefits and policy wording available on request. Should you be extending your tour additional Medical Travel Insurance can be purchased @ R 30 per (under 69 years only) person/ per additional day, valid for maximum 5 days. Should you be extending for longer than 5 days a separate individual Medical travel Insurance may be purchased, please contact us for a quote.

M/S "SERGEY RAKHMANINOV": – All the cabins are basic, 2 single beds, packing space, refrigerator and en-suite bathroom (shower, hand wash basin and toilet). Windows can open. Cabins are basic clean and comfortable. Main deck (2.10 x 4.00 meters) & upper deck cabins (2.15 x 4.65 meters) are about the same size. Upper deck cabins are situated one deck higher than the main deck cabins.

Facilities on board the ship: – Two restaurants, Lounge includes a bar and a dance floor, A beauty salon, Souvenir shop and Doctor onboard. The ship does not have wheelchair access nor an elevator.
